Safety at AIRB is a joint effort, starting with the commitment of the Accountable Manager, who visibly endorses the safety policy and leads the implementation and maintenance of the safety management system and ensures the provision of essential human & financial resources. All levels of management have primary responsibility and commitment to Safety, starting by visibly endorsing the safety policy, promoting and communicating it throughout the organization and business partners.

All airport stakeholders and service providers are primarily responsible for maintaining the highest safety standards & performance conform this policy.

The active participation of the airport community and promotion of a positive safety culture is integral to maintaining a safe airport operations.

We actively create, implement, and continually improve strategies and processes to ensure that all our aviation services meet the highest safety standards according to national and international regulatory requirements and best practices within the aviation industry. The focus on safety emphasizes our dedication to proactive and systematic safety management within the organization and at AIRB.

Mandatory and voluntary safety reporting procedures are integral to our safety management system, aligning with a just culture. Our safety reporting policy principles incorporate a voluntary/anonymous and non-punitive reporting system in which the confidentiality and protection of all safety data and information received is guaranteed. Safety reporting ensures that all airport users can disclose identified hazards without fear of reprisal unless the disclosure indicates illegal acts, gross negligence, or deliberate disregard of regulations or procedures.

Continuous improvement is the foundation of our safety culture. This involves ongoing monitoring, measurement, regular periodical reviews, and adjustment of safety policy, objectives, indicators, and targets, and persistent efforts are undertaken to achieve them. These measures collectively contribute to the improvement of our safety performance. (Please consult the AIRB Key Safety Objectives)
