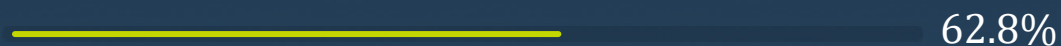

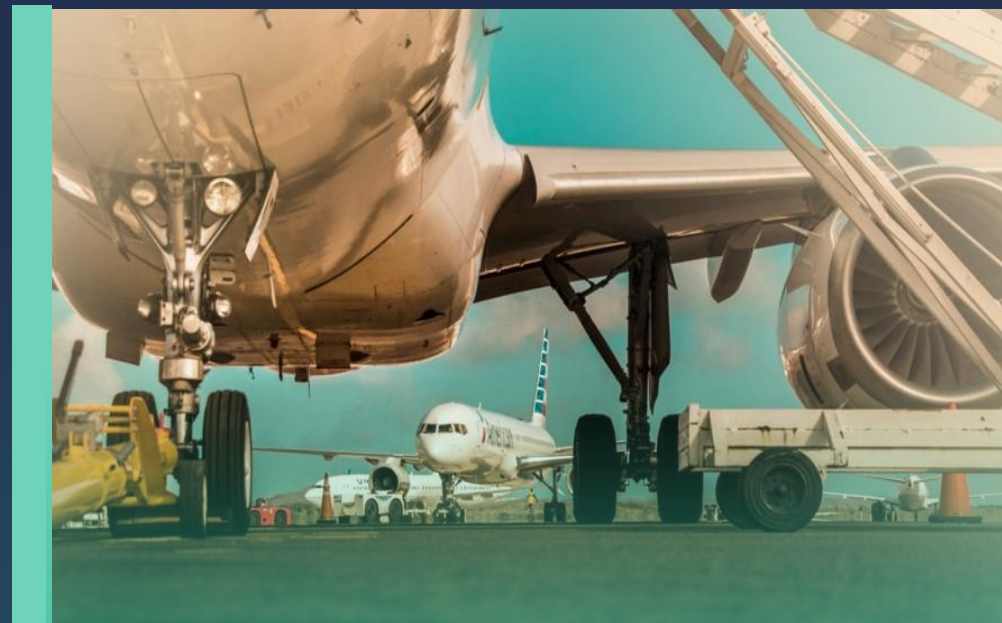

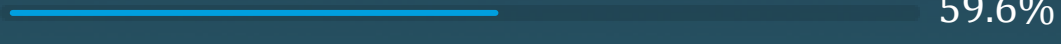

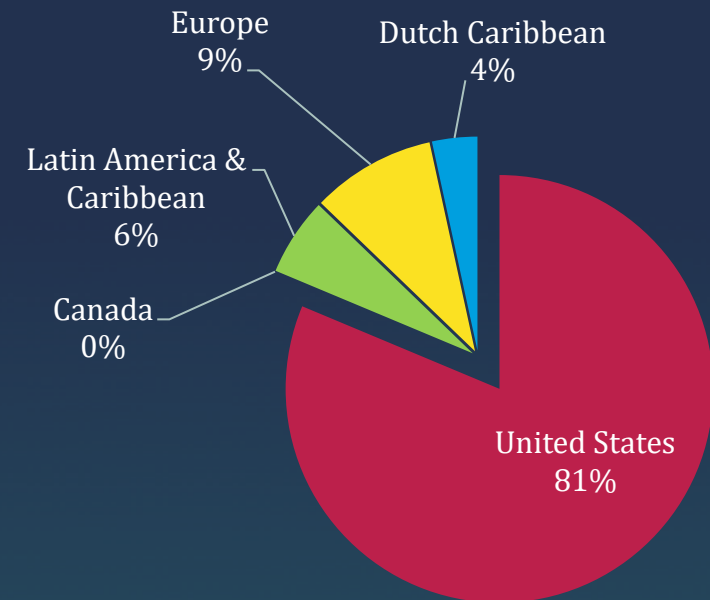
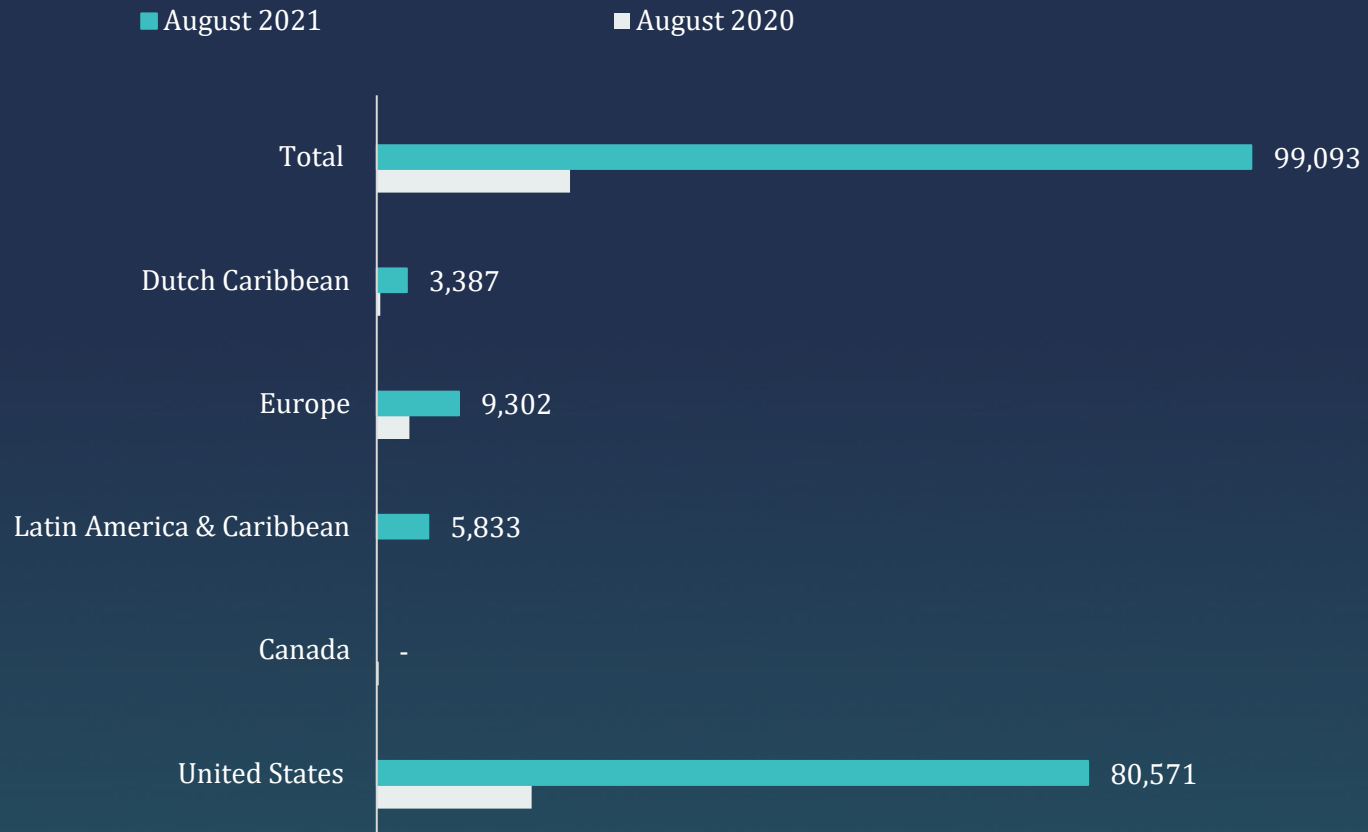

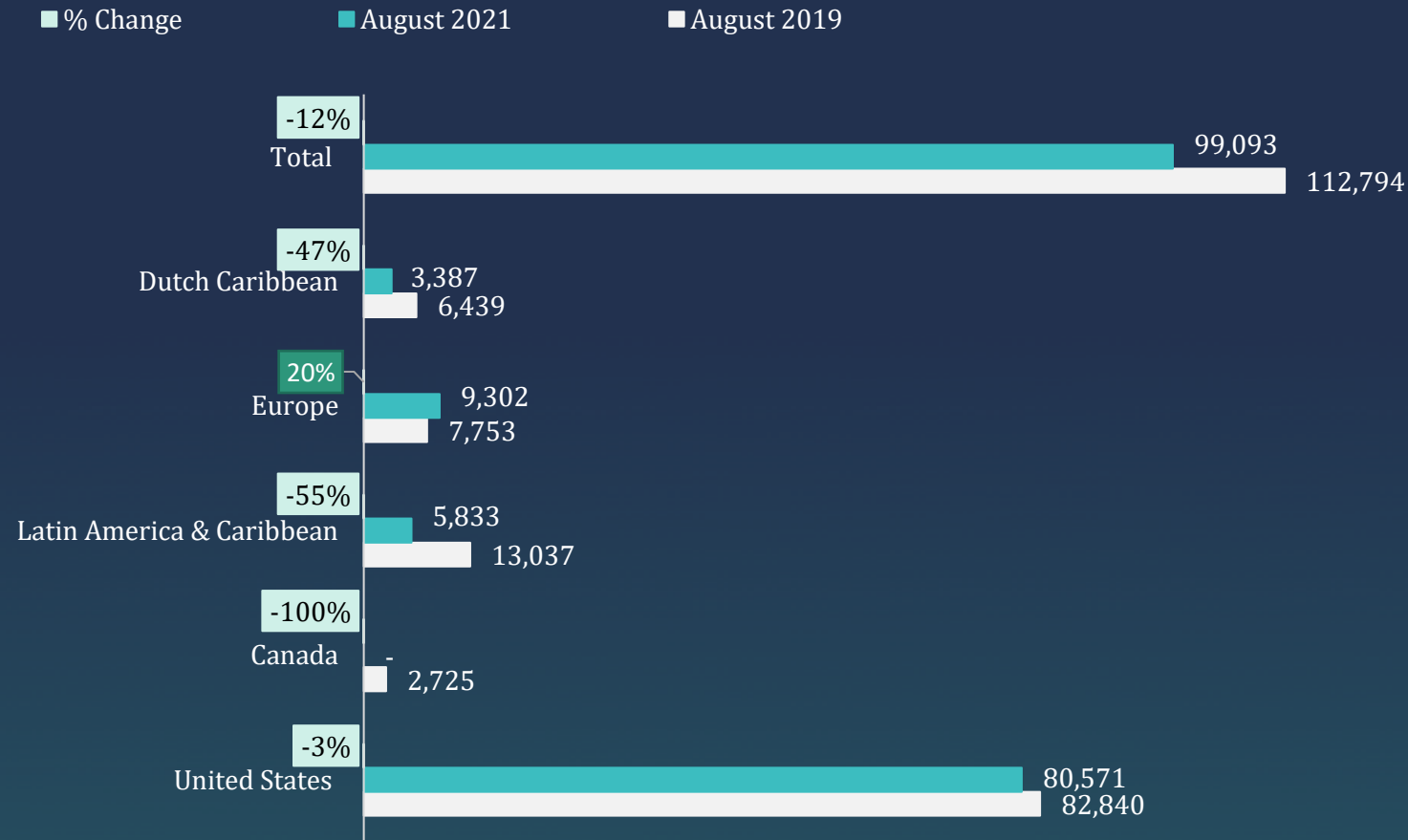

REVENUE GENERATING PASSENGERS (RGPs) BY REGION

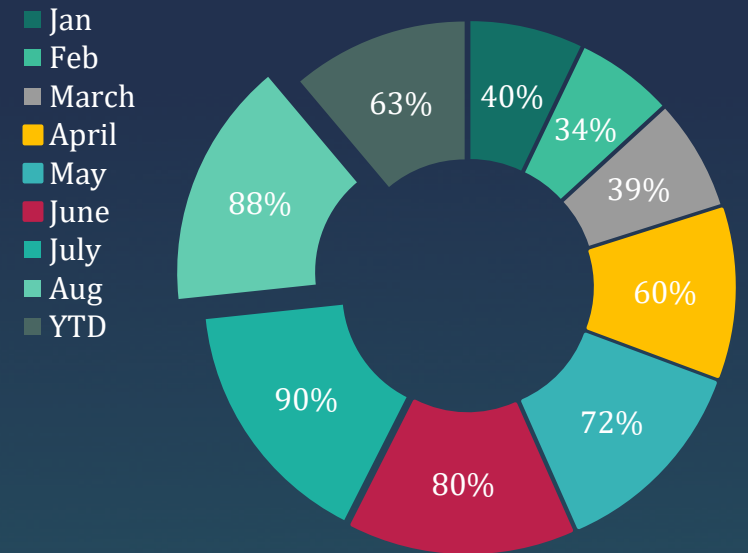

REVENUE GENERATING PASSENGERS (RGPs) BY REGION

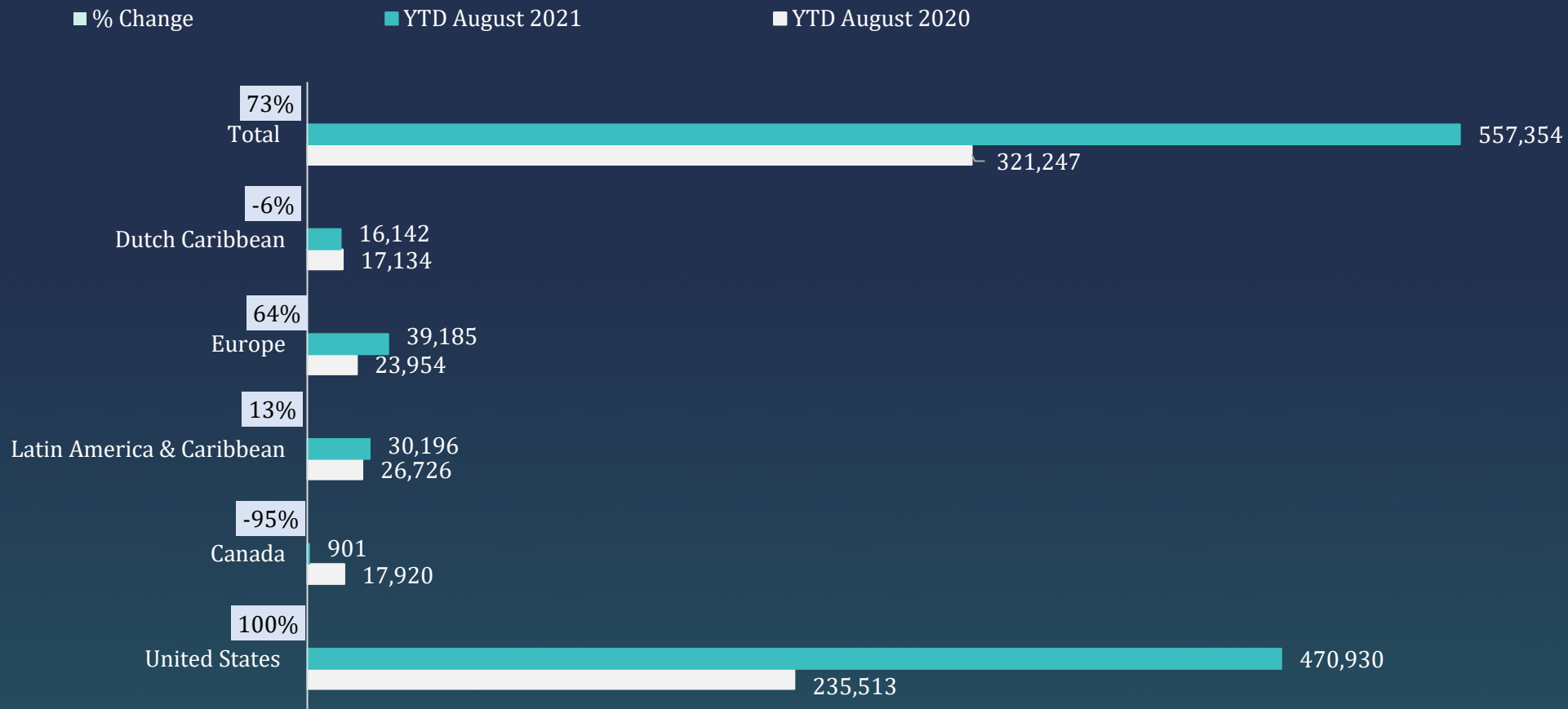


Traffic Recovery Rate vs. 2019

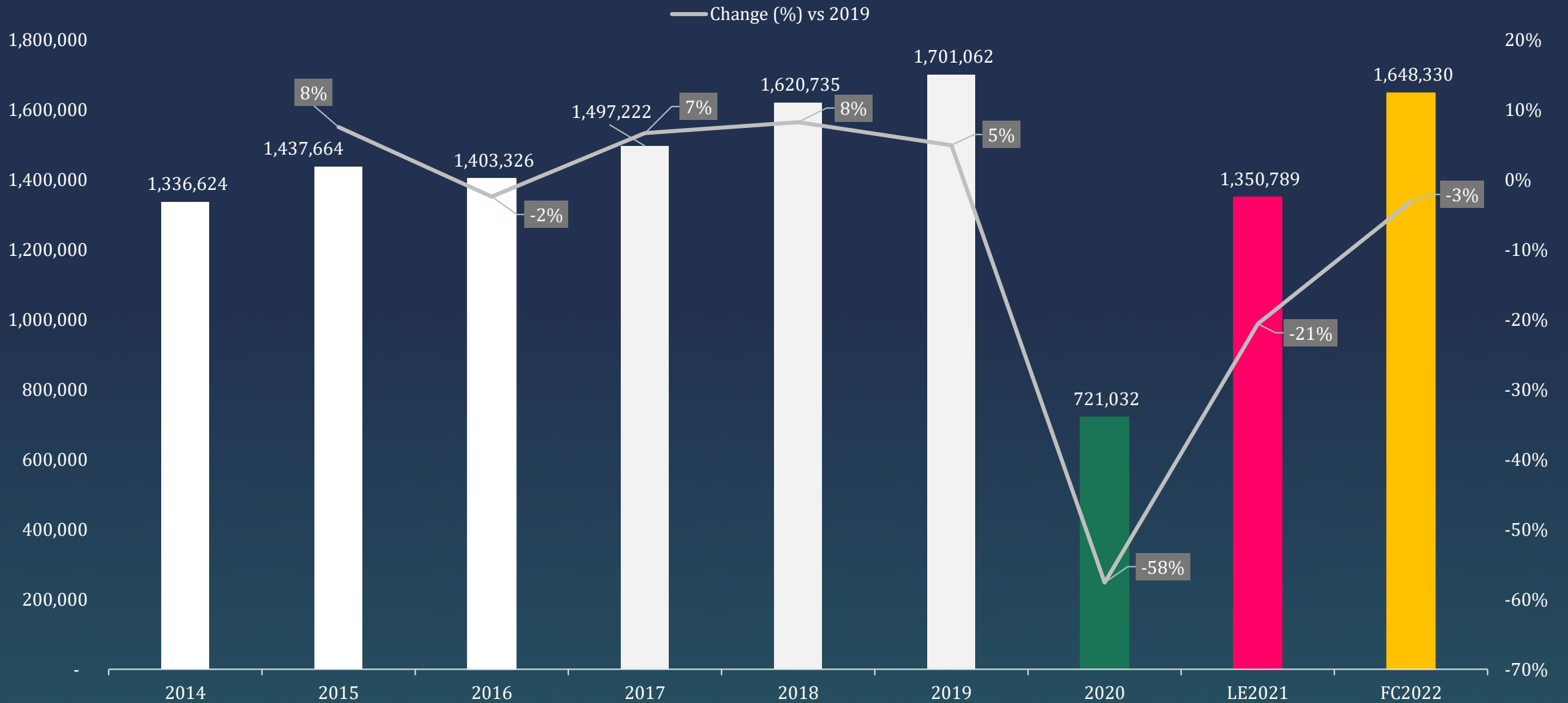

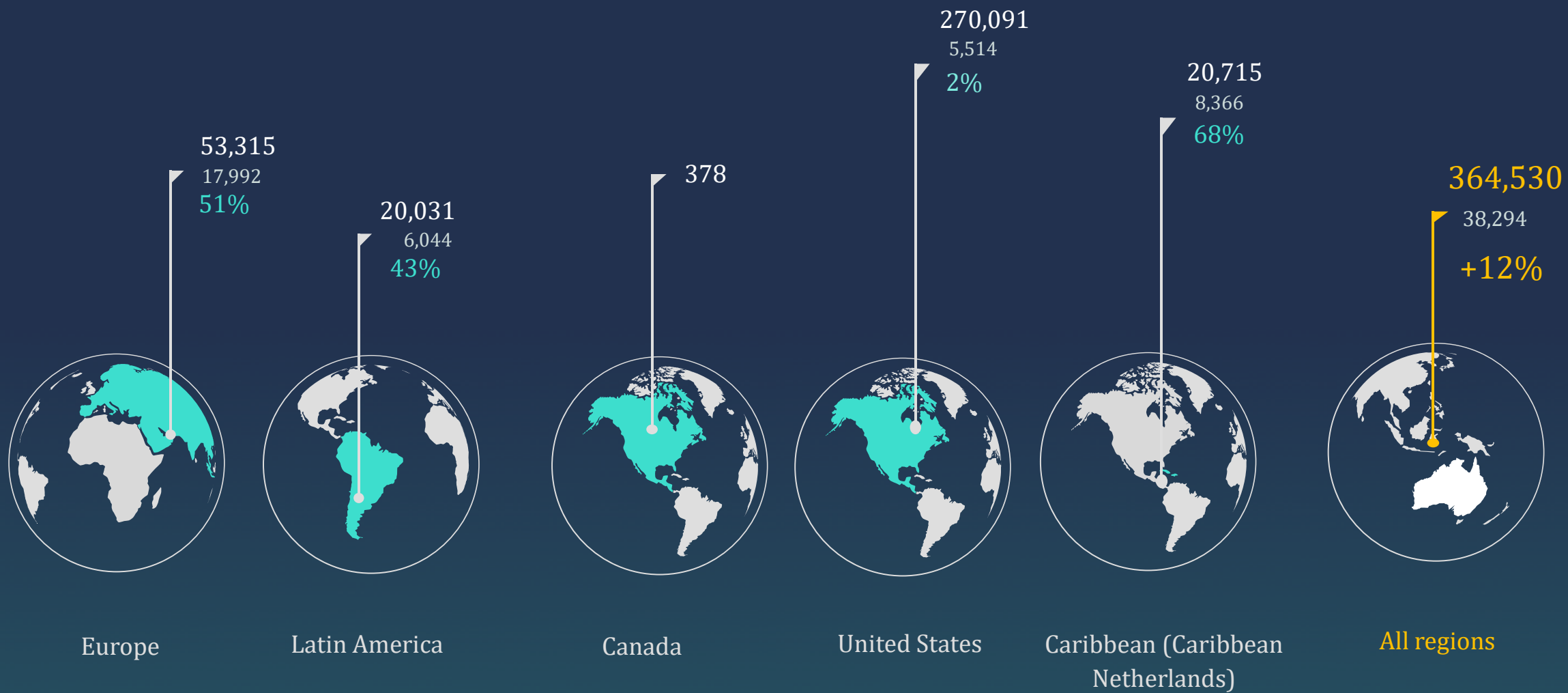

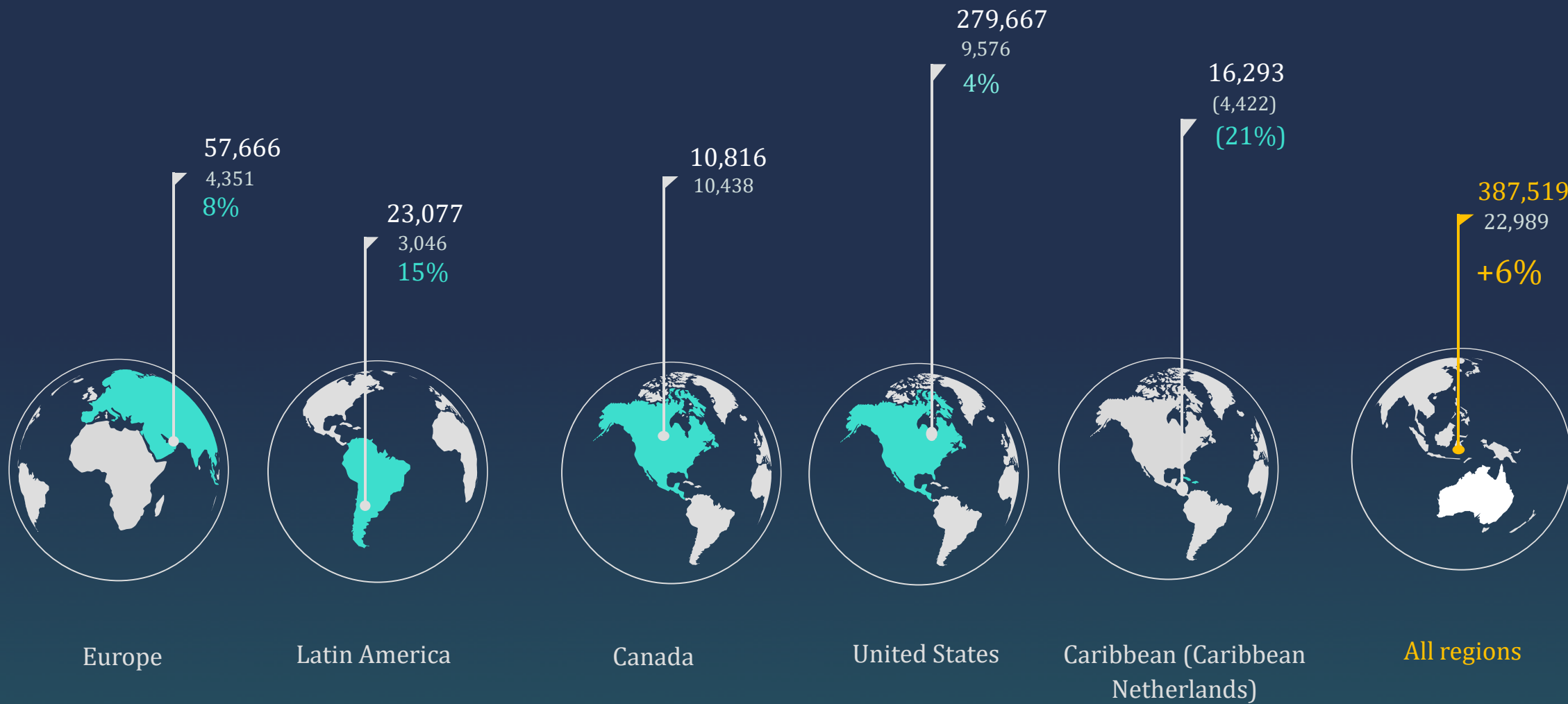
AIR SEAT CAPACITY | OUTLOOK 2022



AIR SEAT CAPACITY | Q3 vs. Q2-2021

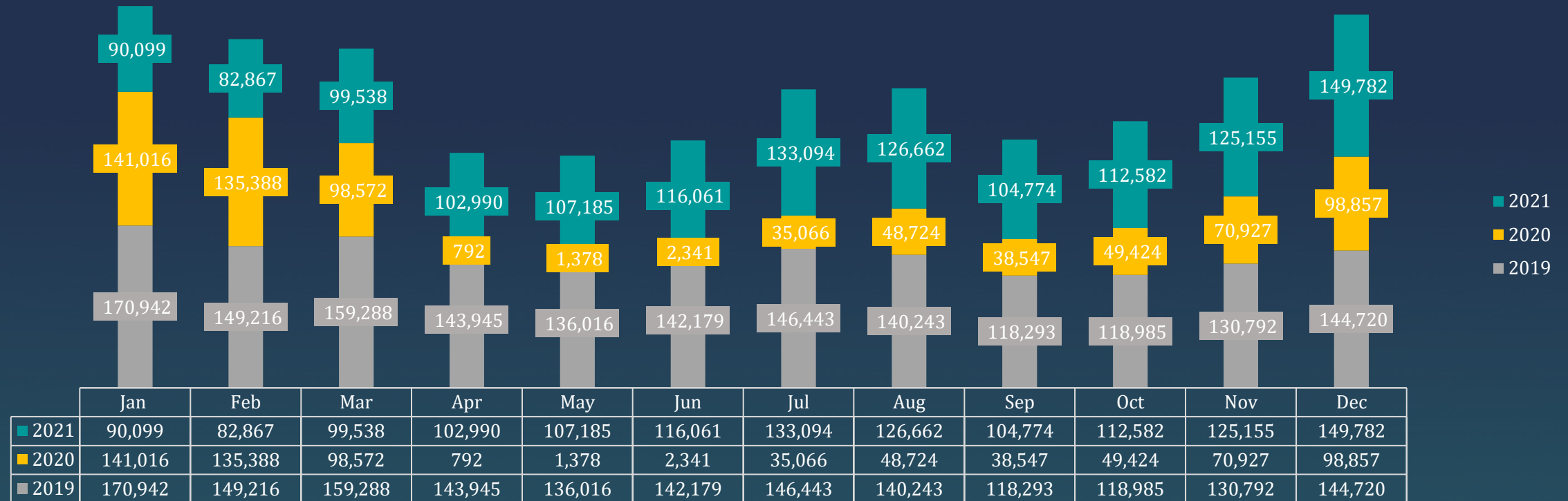


AIR SEAT CAPACITY | Q4 vs. Q3-2021



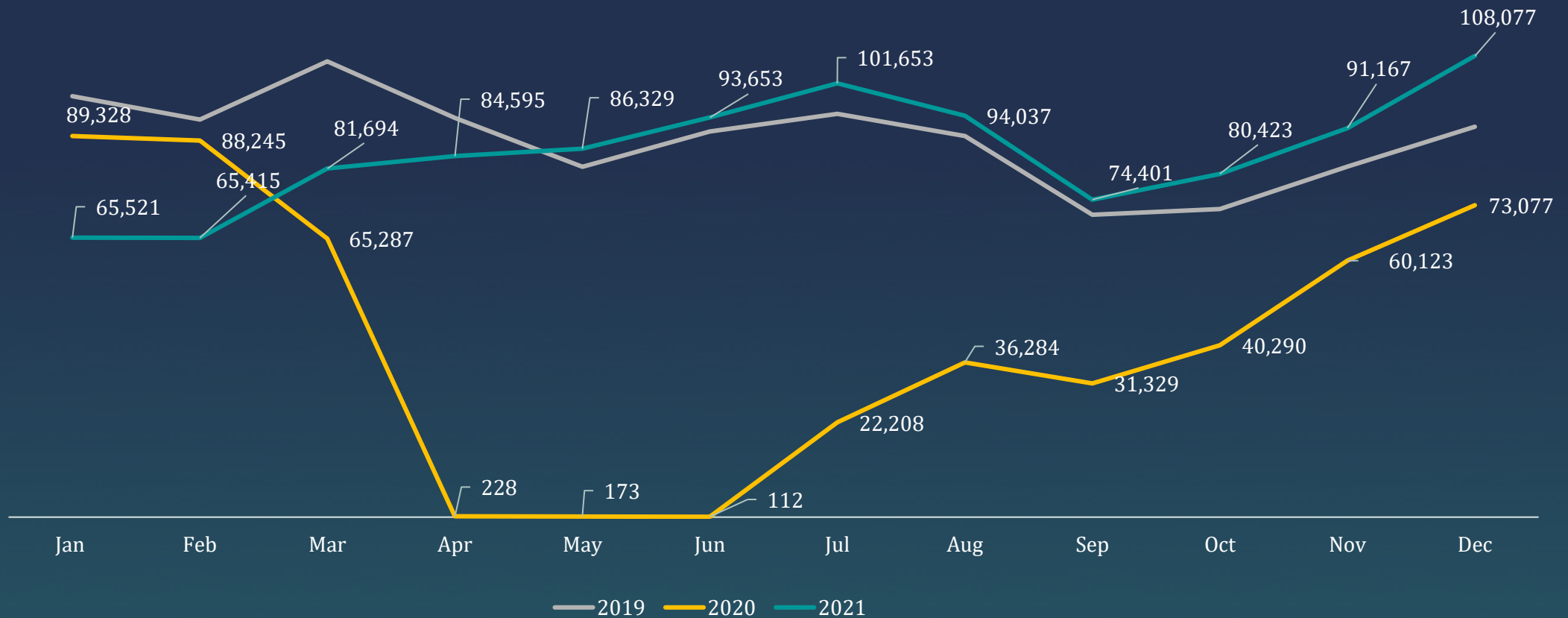

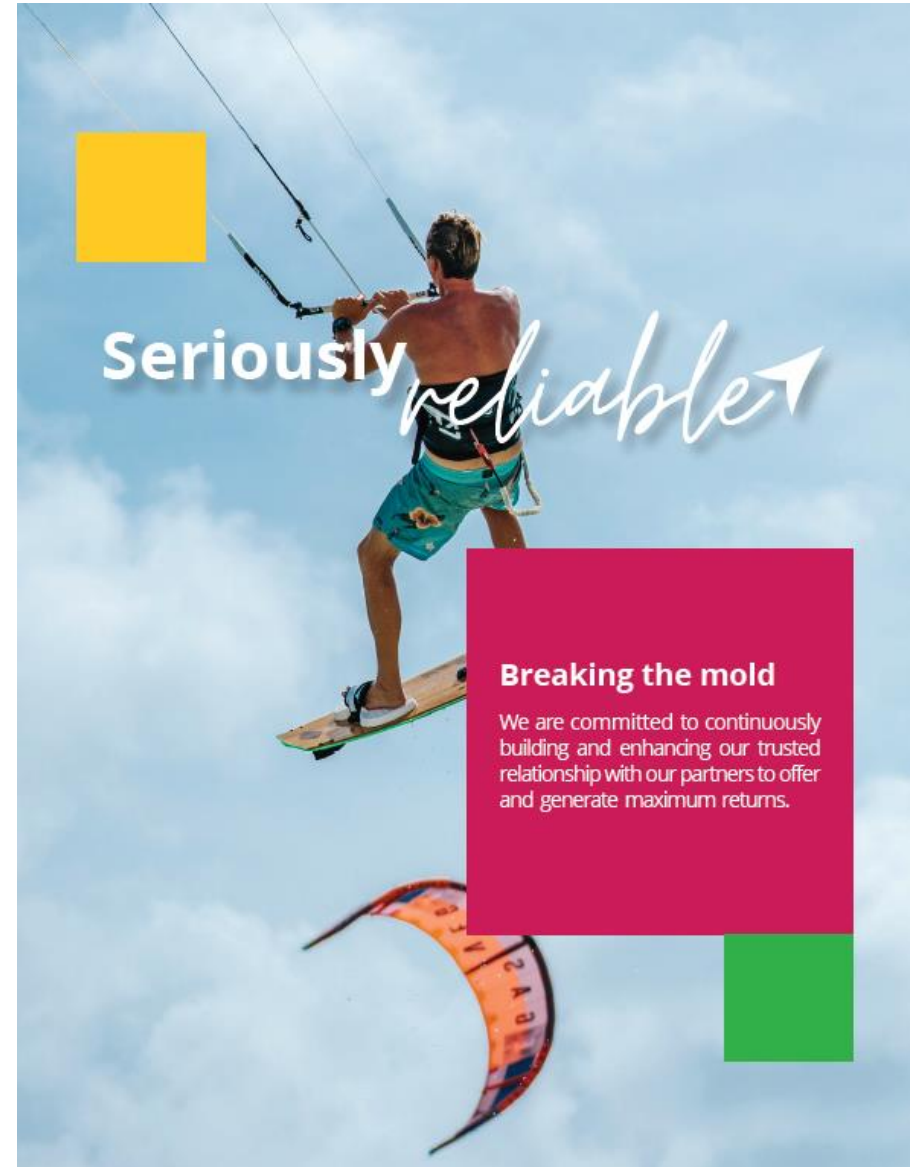
